KNOX (July 17, 2007) – The Starke County Development Foundation announces a new member to Starke County’s Corporate family with the addition of Poly Form International. Poly Form has begun production in the former Freeman Products Building in Knox. Purchased by Bob Qualls of Michigan several years ago after the closure of the Freeman Products facility, the building has been leased to several companies for industrial use. With the addition of Poly Form in the last 50,000 square feet the building is complete occupied.

Poly Form’s President, Richard Negrey, has been in the plastics industry for 25 years. Poly Form manufacturers pick-up truck caps for the European market. The caps are original equipment on many Ford trucks and are assembled in Thailand and sold in Europe. Mr. Negrey designs and builds the Company’s molds and works closely with General Electric in the use of new plastics.
